OP-98 Rejections (Notice/Result) Last Updated: August 16, 2010

OP-98 rejection reports will be posted online daily at 4 p.m. All OP-98 applications received **before 2:30 p.m.** will be reflected on the same day. The OP-98 rejection reports will have data for the last 90 days based on the "Last Updated" date shown above.

OP-98 Rejections are divided into two reports, **Notices** and **Results**. These reports are in Excel ® 97 format. To download the file, right click on the report of your choice, and click on "Save Target As...."

To check whether your job was rejected, please check whether your job number is on the database. To do so, click on the drop down arrow on Job #, choose "Custom" and type your job number. If your job number appears, please check the "Rejected Reason(s)" column to find out why your application was rejected. If your job number does not appear, check [BIS On the Web](#) for details of your acceptance.
